### A real 'Glamour' girl

Cynthia D. Johnson, 21, of Nashville, a senior at Harvard University, has been chosen as one of *Glamour* magazine's Top Ten College Women for 1995 and is featured in the October issue. Johnson is the daughter of the late Tennessee State University professor and minister Dr. Charles DeWitt Johnson and Cleotis Johnson Jones and the step-daughter of Dr. Amos Jones Jr.

Johnson is the first woman minister in her family's five generations of clergy members, serving as an associate minister at Capers Memorial C.M.E. Church in Nashville. She began studying for the ministry at age 20. Last summer she co-founded a program for Boston's inner-city youth, teaching them entrepreneurial skills to raise money for an educational trip to West Africa. Johnson is a graduate of St. Vincent De Paul and Father Ryan High School.

The winners of the competition were selected on the basis of academic excellence and involvement in community activities outside the classroom. Each receives \$1,000.
